DOCUMENTA is a source of information about all that is published in the field of Acoustics, based on a dynamic browsing system and on subject search criteria among the database.

Documenta Acustica is the literature information and distribution system of the EAA.

It contains references to conference and symposia proceedings as well as books, reports and theses.

It helps to publish and

distribute information that is otherwise confined to European acoustical societies, laboratories or companies.

Historically, the Documenta product started as a literature distribution service but it's going to be most a literature information system also because it is hard to compete in selling hard copies of books on acoustics with other big online selling services.

A new function of Documenta, particularly interesting for students, is the Documenta

Publishing service for PHD thesis and Research Project reports: it is now implemented in the webpages a procedure for submission of materials with a specific form that can be downloaded.
